II. THE FOLLOWING LICENSING DEFICIENCIES REQUIRE PROMPT CORRECTION:

NEW 7317.A (Old Tag 5317.A.) Children were not under direct supervision at all times as when I walked into the dinning area, I observed six children sitting in the dinning room eating breakfast who were not under the direct supervision of staff. Based on staff's statement, the children in the dinning room were ages two and three. Later I observed a four and five year old sitting in the dinning room who were not under the direct supervision of a staff. I also observed one of the school age children walk from the three and four year old classroom, located in the back of the center, to the office, located in the front of the center and then back to the three and four year old classroom without the direct supervision of a staff. At two different times, two school age children were observed to walk out of their class room, and walk up the hall to the rest room, located off the dinning room, without the direct supervision of a staff. A child from the three and four year old class also went to the rest room, located off the dinning room, without the direct supervision of a staff.

I hereby acknowledge that I have received the Statement of Deficiencies that was left on-site and acknowledge that I may submit a written response to these deficiencies, including a plan for correction. I understand that these deficiencies could affect the licensing status of this facility and/or place the children in danger. A follow-up visit may be conducted to determine that corrections have been made. I realize the above deficiencies and/or failure to take prompt action to correct any of the above deficiencies may cause the facility to be referred to the appropriate advisory board for denial, revocation or non-renewal of the license. NEW7319.E (Old Tag 5319.E.) Children's food was not served on individual plates, napkins, and paper towels or in cups as appropriate. Specialist observed the breakfast food to be placed directly on to the feeding table for seven one year old children.

NEW 7327.A (Old Tag 5327.A.) Prescription and over-the counter medications, poisons, cleaning supplies, harmful chemicals, equipment, tools, and any substance with a warning label stating it is harmful to or that it should be kept out of the reach of children were not locked away from children as evidenced by a can of glade was sitting on the bath room sink in the bathroom used by the two year old class. A bottle of GermX was observed in a cabinet located under the one year old changing table

NEW7327.H (Old Tag 5327.H.) Strings and cords were within reach of children as in the three and four year old class room the cord to the T.V and the radio are hanging down within the reach of the children. The cord to the window air conditioning unit in the two year old classroom hangs down within the reach of the children.

Dear Ms. Holloway:

The licensing authority for child care facilities, which includes day care centers, is established by Louisiana Revised Statutes 46:1401-et seq. These statutes and the Minimum Standards for licensure of day care centers, that were duly promulgated in accordance with Louisiana law, must be adhered to if a license is to be issued or reissued. Wanda's Kids World, Inc has failed to adhere to these statutes and licensing standards.

As stated in our letter of January 12, 2009 your center was presented to the Louisiana Advisory Committee on Child Care Facilities and Child Placing Agencies on January 14, 2009 for advice and consent regarding the deficiencies that were cited on the licensing visit of December 12, 2008.

The Child Care Licensing and Regulatory Section's recommendation and the Committee's decision are as follows:

License, which expires on May 31, 2009, is hereby REVOKED due to your non-compliance with the Child Day Care Center Class A Minimum Standards as evidenced by Section 7303.D.7 [history of non-compliance] {previous published as 5303.D.7} as previous license (#796) was revoked April 18, 2006; Section 7303.D.2 [indifference to the welfare of children] as director permitted unresponsive two-year-old child to remain at the center and subsequently sent unresponsive child to be transported home as well as the deficiencies noted below:

- **Section 7305.H [children's daily attendance] {previously published as 5305.H} cited on March 4, 2008, July 15, 2008, November 18, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**

- **Section 7308.A [records accessible] {previously published as 5308.A} cited on December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7312.C [annual review] {previously published as 5312.C} cited on March 4, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7312.D.1 [continuing education] {previously cited and published as 5312.D.1} cited on August 1, 2007, October 4, 2007, July 15, 2008, November 18, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7321.J [daily observation of children] {previously published as 5321.J} cited on March 4, 2008, July 15, 2008, November 18, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7321.L [illness and unusual behavior] {previously published as 5321.L} cited on March 4, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7323.B.3 [outdoor enclosed] {previously published as 5323.B.3} cited on December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7331.A [transportation conformed to state law] {previously published as 5331.A} cited on December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7335.B [required staff when transporting children under age 5] {previously published as 5335.B} cited on March 14, 2008 and December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7335.D [master transportation list] {previously published as 5335.D} cited on December 12, 2008;**
- **Section 7335.E [attendance record - vehicle] {previously published as 5335.E} cited on March 4, 2008, July 15, 2008, November 18, 2008 and December 12, 2008; and**
- **Section 7335.F [visual check of vehicle] {previously published as 5335.F} cited on March 4, 2008, July 15, 2008, November 18, 2008 and December 12, 2008.**

You have the right to appeal this action. If you believe this decision has been reached in error or wish to challenge this decision on other legal grounds you may appeal by submitting a copy of this notice, along with a written request to appeal the decision, within thirty days of this notice. A request for appeal should include the specific reasons you believe this decision to be erroneous and/or the specific reasons you believe this decision to be incorrect, and mailed to: DSS APPEALS BUREAU, P.O. BOX 2944, BATON ROUGE, LA 70821.

You also have a right to apply for a new license if you choose not to appeal and believe that you have taken the necessary corrective action. If you choose this option, you may send a signed statement noting your decision as well as your completed application and fee to: DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, CHILD CARE LICENSING AND REGULATORY SECTION, P. O. BOX 3078, BATON ROUGE, LA 70821. In order to obtain a new license you

must be in full compliance with ALL minimum standards, as failure to do so may result in denial of your application. You should carefully review all sections of the minimum standards to determine whether you will be able to meet licensing requirements. You should pay particular attention to Section 7303.D {previously published as 5303.D}, paragraphs 1 – 16, which lists specific grounds for denial, revocation, or non-renewal of a license (see attached). A violation of any of these paragraphs could lead to denial of your application for a new license.

Although we make every effort to assist those we serve, in cases involving the revocation of a license, DSS employees cannot advise you how to proceed. Please be aware that DSS attorneys are not allowed to give legal advice to facilities regulated by the Department. If you are unsure of which option to choose you should consult your personal attorney.

Please note that the Class A Child Day Care Minimum Standards, formerly published in the Louisiana Administrative Code under Title 48, Part I, Chapter 53, Sections 5301-5339, are now published in the Code under Title 67, Part III, Chapter 73, Sections 7301-7339.
